### ***About the College***

Maharshi Paramhansh College of Education, established in 2011, is managed and run by the Maharshi Paramhansh Seva Trust, Ramgarh Cantt. The college is recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) for B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. course. The B.Ed. course is affiliated with Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribagh and the D.El.Ed. course is affiliated with Jharkhand Academic Council, Ranchi.

The college provides Primary (D.El.Ed.) and Secondary level (B.Ed.) teacher training program. It aims to produce quality teachers to form a learning society because quality teachers imply quality education and quality education determines quality of life of people in a society. It is an honest effort for imparting teacher education in Jharkhand.

Maharshi Paramhansh College of Education with its exceptional infrastructure and an excellent team of well qualified and highly accomplished faculty members with strong academic and teaching background will contribute constructively towards preparing professionally efficient teachers worthy to learn, earn and serve the society. Our procedure, systems and pedagogy are totally geared towards helping the trainees so that they can achieve their goals of becoming an ideal teacher.

### ***Mission***

### ***Aims and objectives***

1. To prepare committed, highly skillful and effective teachers to teach at Primary, Secondary and Senior Secondary level school for the state of Jharkhand and the nation.
2. To offer an all round training to teachers so that they are fit on all the fronts i.e. mental, physical, cultural, social, moral and spiritual.
3. To prepare good professionals in the field of education.
4. To impart quality education for skill development and capacity building.

### ***Location***

The college campus is situated just 100 yards away from the National Highway (NH-23) and is well connected from all the cities of Jharkhand.

**Road :** The college campus can be reached from Ramgarh Cantt towards 6 Km east on the Ramgarh-Bokaro Highway (NH-23) and is 100 meters from Ramgarh District Civil Court.

Distance from: Ranchi – 50 Km, Hazaribagh – 55 Km, Bokaro – 55 Km

**Rail :** Ramgarh Cantt, Ranchi Road, Barkakana, Ranchi and Bokaro are the important railway stations nearby.

**Air :** The nearest airport is the Birsa Munda Airport at Ranchi located approximately 60 Km away.



## INFRASTRUCTURE

### *Campus*

The college campus is spread on over 85 decimal area amidst lush green surroundings in a very peaceful area having wonderful scenic beauty.

The main college building (Ground+3 floors) with buildup area 4535 sq. mt. has all in-house facilities required for a B.Ed. & D.El.Ed. courses. The main building comprises of Class Rooms, Library, Laboratories, Multipurpose Hall (with a seating capacity of 300students), Principal Office, Administrative Office, Faculty Room, Indoor Games, Separate Boys and Girls Room etc. under one roof.

In addition, the main building is equipped with facilities such as Canteen, Drinking water, Electricity, Internet, Xerox facilities, Wi-Fi campus, Separate Boys, Girls and Staff Wash Room etc.

Outside the main building a large playground for Outdoor Games and other activities, Parking shed and Gardening is also available.

### *Class Rooms*

The institute boasts of spacious, well-ventilated, lighted and excellently furnished classrooms to make the students learning comfortable and enjoyable.

### *Library-cum-Reading Room*

Our college library has around 5000 books (1000+ titles) covering the entire syllabus of B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. courses along with subscription to a number of educational journals, newspapers and magazines. The library reading room has a seating capacity of 100 students. Library cards are issued to all the students which is valid till the completion of the course. Photocopy facility has also been provided in the library.

### *ICT & ET Resource Centre*

Information and Communication Technology (ICT) is an umbrella term that includes all tools and techniques to enhance the effectiveness of the teaching-learning process. The college has a state of the art ICT & ET lab with 20 personal computer systems for the students, Scanning and Printing facilities, LED T.V., LED Projector, OHP, DVD Player, Audio equipments.



### ***Curriculum Laboratory***

The curriculum laboratory is dedicated for Mathematics and Science subjects. The lab is well equipped with all the scientific apparatus to apply the classroom theory in practical situation. It also has models, charts, graphs, pictures, etc to demonstrate, explain and reinforce scientific knowledge. The experiments are carried out by the teachers or the students themselves to explore and stimulate interest towards Science and Mathematics.

### ***Psychology Resource Centre***

The college has a separate Psychology Resource Centre with sufficient psychological apparatus to conduct tests as per the B.Ed./D.El.Ed. syllabus such as mirror drawing test, intelligence test, memory test, some paper tests on personality and teacher effectiveness test which prepares our teacher trainees to understand the psychology of students and apply it to make their teaching more effective.

### ***Health and Physical Education Resource Centre***

Sports and physical training constitutes an essential part of education. Our college has a fully equipped health & physical resource centre. It provides ample opportunities for students to indulge in indoor & outdoor sports activities. Facility for outdoor games include two full size courts marked out for playing Badminton and Volleyball. Indoor games facilities include Table Tennis, Chess, Carom-boards, etc along with a dedicated space for Yoga. We aim to help provide students with adequate resources for their physical fitness.

### ***Arts and Craft Resource Centre***

Art and Craft resource centre is housed in a well designed spacious room with facilities for music (Harmonium, Keyboard, Tabla, Dholak, Veena and Flute), drawing & painting, stitching & tailoring, origami and woodwork. Students can utilize all these for their creative works of arts and crafts.



## **Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed. Course)**

The elementary teacher education program (i.e. for classes I to VIII) is also known as B.T.C, J.B.T., D.Ed., P.T.T., etc.

### ***Duration:***

The D.El.Ed. course is of Two academic year (Four semesters). There shall be at least 200 teaching days in college each year consisting of class room teaching, micro teaching, demonstration & skill development, practice teaching (Internship) in nearby primary school - 4 weeks in first year 16 weeks in second year.

### ***Intake:***

Only 50 students will be admitted in one academic year. Reservation policy shall be as per the rules of the Government of Jharkhand.

### ***Eligibility criteria for students:***

As per NCTE norms, a candidate should have secured at least 50% marks (45% for ST/SC/OBC) in Intermediate (+2) level and completed 18 years of age as on 30<sup>th</sup> June of the admission year.

### ***Medium of Instruction:***

The medium of instruction will be Hindi and English. Examinations may be written in Hindi or English except in language subjects.

### ***Class Attendance:***

All D.El.Ed. students must attend 80% of classes & practice teaching organized by the college as per NCTE & Jharkhand Academic Council (JAC) norms. Students who fail to attend the classes organized by the college will not be allowed to fill-up the form for final examination. All students must also participate in the co-curricular & other activities organized by the college.

### ***Sessional Examination:***

One sessional examination will be organized by the college for sessional evaluation in every semester. Students must appear for each sessional examination. Based on the sessional examination results, college will confidentially send sessional marks to the Jharkhand Academic Council which is a part of the total evaluation of D.El.Ed. students.



## ***Bachelor of Education (B.Ed. Course)***

### ***Duration:***

The B.Ed. course is of Two academic year (Four semesters). There shall be at least 200 working days in each academic year exclusive of the period of examination and admission.

### ***Intake:***

Only 100 students will be admitted in one academic year. Reservation policy shall be as per the rules of the Government of Jharkhand.

### ***Eligibility criteria for students:***

As per the NCTE norms, a candidate should have secured at least 50% marks (45% for ST/SC/OBC) in aggregate in the Bachelor's Degree or Master's degree in Science/Social Science/Humanity, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science & Mathematics with 55% marks or any other equivalent qualification from a recognized university.

### ***Medium of Instruction:***

The medium of instruction will be Hindi and English. Examinations may be written in Hindi or English except in language subjects.

### ***Class Attendance:***

All B.Ed. students must attend 80% of classes organized by the college as per NCTE & university norms. Students who fail to attend the classes organized by the college will not be allowed to fill-up the form for final University examination. All students must also participate in the co-curricular & other activities organized by the college.

### ***Sessional Examination:***

One sessional examination will be organized by the college for sessional evaluation in every semester. Students must appear for each sessional examination. Based on the sessional examination results, college will confidentially send sessional marks to the university which is a part of the total evaluation of B.Ed. students.

### ***Practice teaching:***

The college will organize micro-teaching classes, demonstration lesson and skill-development sessions before organizing practice teaching in nearby secondary schools for 4 weeks in first year and for 16 weeks in second year. Students must attend at least 90% of practice teaching, failing which he/she will not be allowed to appear in the final University examination.





### ***How to Apply***

Application forms can be obtained from the college office or can be downloaded from our college website

Fill the application form in BLOCK LETTERS. All columns are to be filled. If any part is Not Applicable please mention it as NA. Application is to be duly filled in and signed by the candidate.

A recent colored passport size photograph has to be pasted on the application form.

Candidates have to submit the application form along with required documents as mentioned in Application form. Application not accompanied with requisite documents / enclosures or received after the due date shall be summarily rejected.

The completed application form has to be submitted to Maharshi Paramhansh College of Education, Village: Huhua (Kothar), NH-23, Near District Court, P.O. Ramgarh Cantt – 825101, Dist: Ramgarh (Jharkhand) along with a Demand Draft of Rs.700/- (Rs.500/- for SC/ST candidates) drawn in favor of Maharshi Paramhansh College of Education payable at Ramgarh Cantt branch.

Application forms should be submitted to the college office personally or should reach to the college office by post before closure date.

Incomplete or late applications or furnishing false information will be liable to summarily rejection of application without giving any information to the concerned candidates.

Candidates who secure admission on the basis of false certificate/marks sheet or on the basis of any misrepresentation of facts or illegal means, their admission shall be summarily cancelled and all fees paid by him/her shall be forfeited. Legal action shall also be taken against them.

### ***Selection of Candidates for Admission***

Selection of candidates for admission will be done strictly in accordance with the merit list prepared on the basis of academic qualification. Merit list for point system will be prepared following the guidance of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of Jharkhand.

List of selected candidates will be made available on the college notice board. Selected candidates will be provided stipulated time for admission, failing which he/she can't claim for admission and the seat would be offered to the candidate in the waiting list.

### ***Documents required at the time of admission:***

Selected candidate called for admission must produce the following documents in original for physical verification:

1. All the documents submitted with the Application
2. College leaving certificate / Department leaving certificate
3. Registration number of JAC / Vinoba Bhave University (if any) or Migration certificate of university from which the candidate received his last Intermediate / Bachelor / Master degree
4. Four copies of recent passport size photograph same as pasted in the application form
5. No objection certificate from the employer (if the applicant is employed)
6. Caste Certificate in case of ST / SC / OBC candidates
7. Residential Certificate
8. Aadhaar Card

## **General Rules and Regulations**

### **1. Discontinuance:**

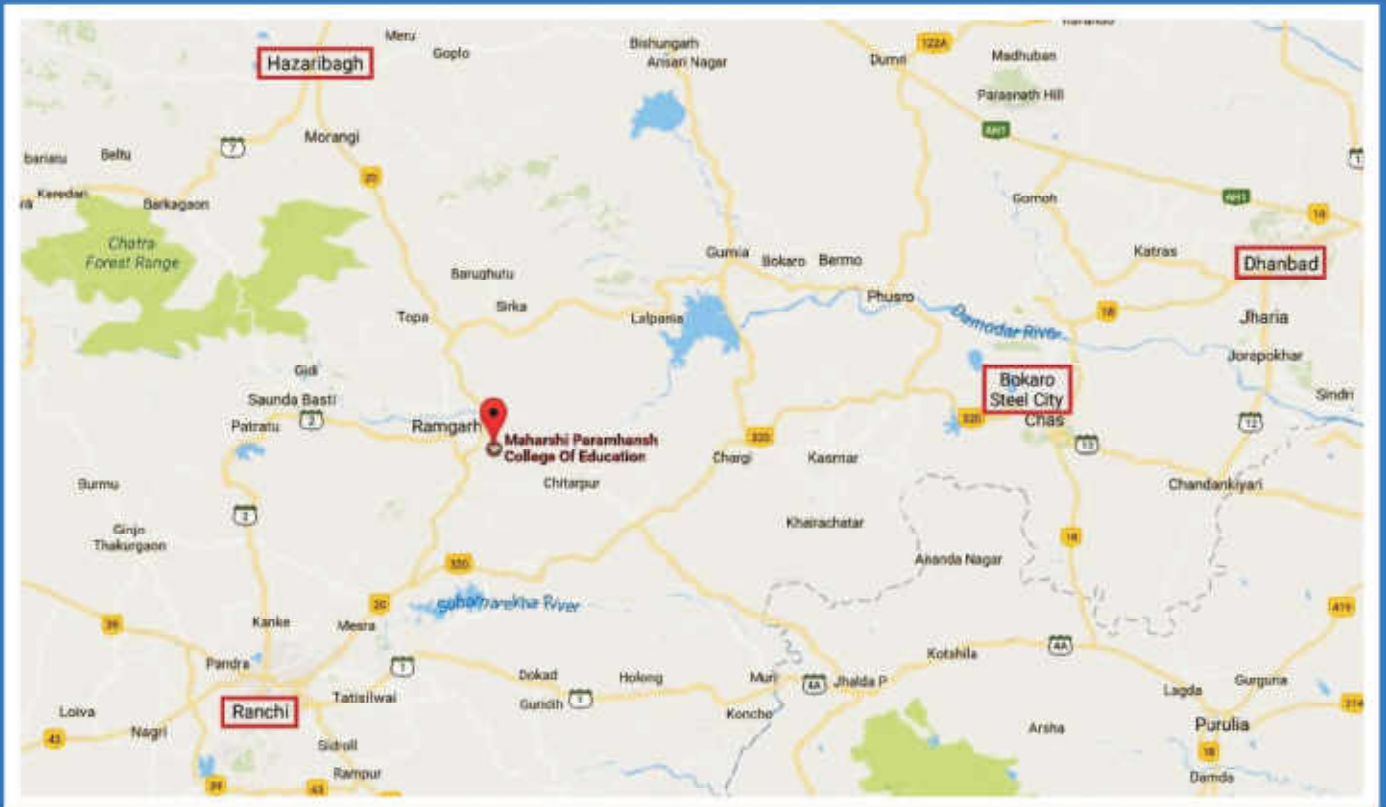
- a) In case any trainee is found not paying his/her fees within 15 days from the due date he/she will fetch strong disciplinary measures.
  - b) If any trainee opts to drop out from the course the case will also be treated as discontinuance and in such a situation, the course fee and other charges already paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
  - c) In case of absence for 15 consecutive days, the college must be informed of valid reason or else the case will be treated as discontinuance.
  - d) In case of misconduct and violation of college norms, trainees may fetch disciplinary action leading to discontinuance.
2. No refund of fees will be made on withdrawal of admission under any circumstances.
  3. In case the candidate fails to submit the required documents then his/her admission shall be treated as cancelled and no request for refund of fees will be entertained under any circumstances.
  4. All the trainees will strictly comply with the rules and regulations of the college issued from time to time relating to their studies, examination conduct and discipline.
  5. Trainees are liable to security checks on entry or exit from the college premises.
  6. The college will not be responsible for any loss of belongings left unattended by the trainees at the college premises.
  7. Intake of any sort of intoxicating substance is strictly prohibited. Smoking, chewing of Paan or Gum is also prohibited.
  8. Being late for the class is not only detrimental to the academic progress of the late comer, but is disruptive for the entire class also. Trainees arriving late will not be allowed to enter the college campus and will be marked absent. Disciplinary actions will be taken against persistent habituals.
  9. A medical certificate will be required if there are more than three days consecutive absence owing to illness.
  10. All the college properties have to be handled with care. Any damage or pilferage caused to the college properties by any trainee will be appropriately charged.
  11. Trainees should strictly adhere to instructions regarding entry/exit regulations, parking of vehicles etc. They should not bring friends, visitors or relatives to the class rooms or practical rooms.
  12. Telephones at college are meant for official purpose and not for personal calls. Only in case of dire emergencies, telephone calls will be allowed for trainees. This facility cannot be claimed as a matter of right.
  13. Ragging is strictly banned in the college and any one indulging in ragging process is likely to be punished appropriately.
  14. All trainees are supposed to attend the classes in proper uniform as prescribed by the college administration suited for a gentle man/woman.
  15. Male trainees must have short and properly groomed hair, clean and well trimmed nails. They should attend classes every day with a clean shave and polished shoe.
  16. Female trainees must have properly groomed hair, clean and well trimmed nails without nail polish. Perfumes should not be used while attending theory or practical classes.
  17. During class hours wearing the college Identity Card is compulsory.
  18. The college holds the right to introduce, alter, amend or change any or all the rules from time to time, if, found necessary.
  19. For any legal dispute the jurisdiction will be at Ramgarh Court only.

### **Ragging :**

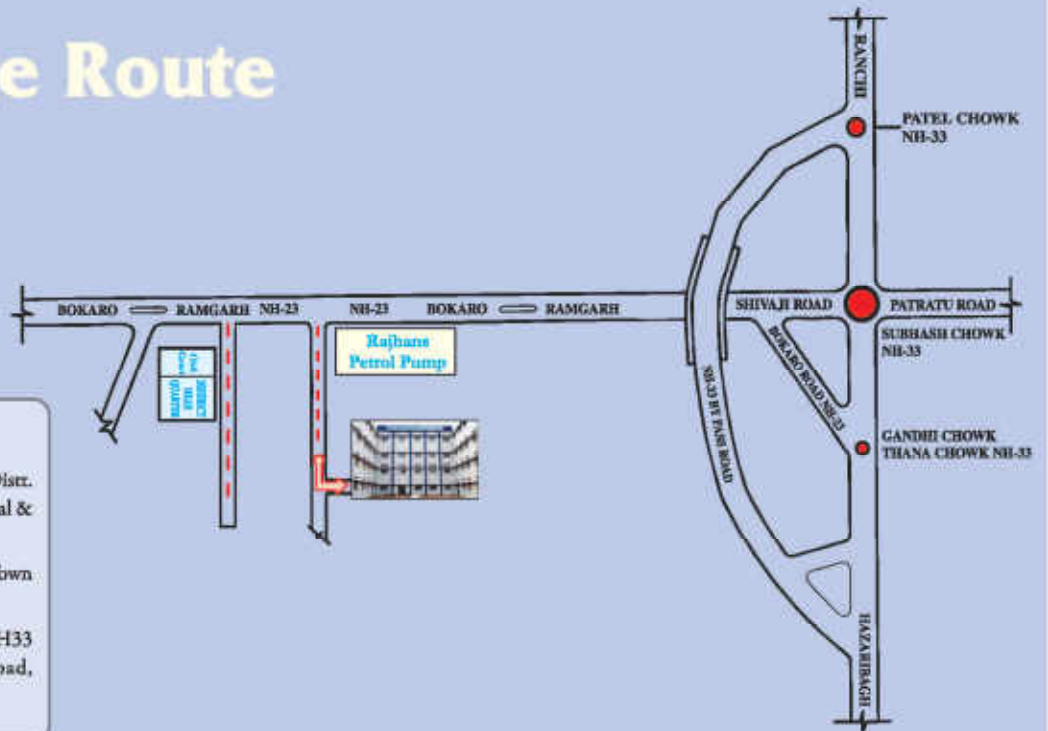
